Vision: Thornton Public Library would like to provide its patrons with access to the most current information in a timely basis.

Technology Needs: As we enter into another decade, we need to continue providing internet. Thornton Public Library being a small library, SWAN is a necessity – it "increases" out collection!

Current Technology: Thornton Public Library provides internet access computers for the patrons to use. Our Patrons have access to materials from other libraries through SWAN (System Wide Automated Network).

Goals:

- 1. Our first goal is to continue having a staff member be trained in today's technology. Estimated Cost: \$1000 per year. FY 2010-2011
- Thornton Public Library would like to place 3 internet access computers for their patrons. Current computers are from 2003. Estimated cost: \$2500. FY 2011-2012
- Thornton Public Library has their collection automated. We hope to continue providing SWAN for our patrons. Estimated Cost: \$8000-\$10000 per year. FY 2010-2015
